


Let's learn: Vocabulary words









Let's read: Useful Expression

I am looking for...

Do you have this in (size/ color)?

It is out of stock.

How much is this?

It is on sale.



Let's read: Dialogue



Hi, may I help you?

Salesclerk

I am looking for a gift for my mother on her birthday next week.



Jess



Do you have something in mind, Ma'am?

Salesclerk

Oh, this one. This bag is so pretty. Do you have this in red color?



Jessa



I'll check, first. Please for wait a while.



Jessa



Sure.



I'm sorry. The item is out of stock.

Salesclerk

Really? Too bad.



Jessa



How about the white one? I'm sure it will look great on your mother.

Salesclerk

Really? Okay. I'll get the white one, then. How much is it?



Jessa



It's on sale, so the price will be \$5 only.
